1. Status Conference with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the PSC and the Defendant

A status conference was held on this date in the Chambers of Judge Eldon E. Fallon to discuss the Defendant's Motion to Compel the Deposition of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the related United States' Motion to Quash the Subpoena and/or for a Protective Order. In attendance on behalf of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (the "Corps") was Traci L. Colquette, in attendance for the Plaintiffs were Sidney Torres, Joseph Bruno and Gerald Meunier, and in attendance for Defendant were Kerry Miller, Rasch Brown, George Frilot, III and Paul Thibodeaux. IT IS ORDERED that by July 28, 2006, the Defendant shall submit a letter to the Corps addressing the issues raised by the Corps in its June 30, 2006 letter to the Defendant. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Corps shall have until August 4, 2006 to respond to the Defendant's letter, and the parties shall contact the Court by telephone on August 4, 2006 at 3:30 p.m. to discuss the decision.

2. Monthly Status Conference

A monthly status conference was held on this date in the Courtroom of Judge Eldon E. Fallon. In attendance on behalf of Plaintiffs were various members of the PSC. In attendance for Defendant were various members of the Defendant's counsel. At the conference, counsel reported to the Court on the topics set forth in the Joint Agenda of Plaintiffs' and Defendant's liaison counsel. Additionally, Defendant's counsel stated a concern regarding the need for testing before scheduled demolition began on homes within the certified class area. IT IS ORDERED that the Defendants shall notify the PSC in advance of any testing prior to the demolition of houses.
