## **ORDER**

A status conference was held on this date with counsel for all parties participating. The parties discussed preparations for the June 24, 2013 hearing.

The Court inquired as to the parties' intentions with respect to the selection of a Monitor. Counsel for the Plaintiff Class, the United States, and the Sheriff of Orleans Parish advised the Court that they anticipated that the Plaintiff Class and the United States would submit names to the Sheriff for his consideration. Although not required by the Consent Judgment, they also advised the Court of their willingness to share their suggestions with the City of New Orleans ("City") and to welcome additional suggestions from the City. Counsel for the City expressed its interest in providing additional suggestions and reviewing the suggestions of the other parties.

The Court advised the parties that it requires further briefing on the streams of revenue, if any, that the Sheriff is legally obligated to use for Orleans Parish Prison ("OPP").

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that counsel for the Sheriff shall submit a memorandum of law on or before Monday, June 17, 2013, identifying streams of revenue, including those coming from the City, that the Sheriff is legally obligated to use for OPP.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Plaintiff Class, United States, and City shall file memoranda of law in response on or before Wednesday, June 19, 2013.
