## PUBLIC NOTICE

The current terms of the office of United States Magistrate Judges Daniel E. Knowles, III and Joseph C. Wilkinson, Jr. at New Orleans, Louisiana, are due to expire January 5, 2011 and March 26, 2011, respectively. The United States District Court is required by law to establish a panel of citizens to consider the reappointment of the magistrate judge to a new eight year term.

The duties of a magistrate judge include the following: (1) conduct of most preliminary proceedings in criminal cases; (2) trial and disposition of misdemeanor cases; (3) conduct of various pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings on delegation from a district judge; and (4) trial and disposition of civil cases upon consent of the litigants.
