Public Notice is hereby given of proposed amendment to the Local Criminal Rules of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana. The court proposes to abrogate LCrR 23.1 in its entirety since current statutory and case law address this issue.

LCrR23.1 Trial by Jury

Trial by jury in criminal cases shall be limited to those cases in which a crime is charged for which the maximum possible penalty exceeds imprisonment for a period of six months or a fine of \$500, or both.
