Pursuant to Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Public Notice is hereby given of proposed amendments to the Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana with the new language underlined and the old language lined-through:

10.2 Confidentiality. Complaints of misconduct and other records of disciplinary proceedings, except orders imposing public discipline, must not be made public by the clerk, court or committee except upon order of the court. All disciplinary proceedings must be heard in chambers conducted under seal, unless the respondent requests a hearing in open court. Notwithstanding the foregoing, a complainant or respondent is not prohibited from making public any documents or information in that person's possession.
