IT IS ORDERED that <u>Alana Alexander and Christopher Cooper</u> shall serve as the bellwether plaintiffs against Gulf Stream Coach, Inc. in the September 14, 2009 trial.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Shalahn Jenkins and Craig Jenkins, Jr. shall serve as the bellwether plaintiffs against Fleetwood Canada, Ltd., Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., Fleetwood Homes of North Carolina, Inc., Fleetwood Homes of Georgia, Inc., and Fleetwood Travel Trailers of Maryland, Inc. (collectively "Fleetwood") in the October 26, 2009 trial.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to the agreement reached by the parties, Lyndon Wright shall serve as the bellwether plaintiff against Forest River, Inc. in the December 7, 2009 trial.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that <u>Diana Bell</u> shall serve as the bellwether plaintiff against Keystone RV Company in the January 11, 2010 trial.
