ORDER AMENDING RULES FOR LAWYER DISCIPLINARY ENFORCEMENT

Pursuant to a majority vote of the active judges of this court;

IT IS ORDERED that Rule 4.1 et seg of the Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary

Enforcement of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana are

hereby amended as follows:

Rule 4.1 Committee. The Lawyer Disciplinary Committee consists of seven (7)

twelve (12) members of the bar appointed by the court *en banc*.

**4.1.1 Term.** Each committee member serves at the pleasure of the court.

However, the term of each committee member is usually three (3) years. The

terms of the members of the committee are staggered so that no more than

two (2) four (4) members are replaced each year.

**4.1.2 Quorum.** The quorum necessary for the committee to act consists of

five (5) seven (7) members of the committee.
