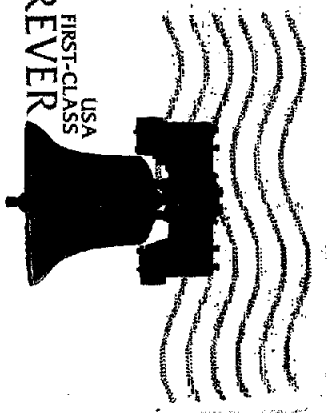

On the morning of January 7, 2011 at Orleans Parish Prison A2-tier, I was stabbed several times by inmates unknown to me, but one of them occupied the same cell with me. I fought them, from cell-R6 to the break room area of A2-tier. The deputy did not respond to the event until I knock or kick on door several times before he actually responded to the altercation, after the deputy open the door, bleeding from my injuries, I was taken to Medical at Orleans Parish Prison and not taken out to a hospital. The medical director requested I need several stitches but after he received a phone call his request was denied. A Lieutenant Ruiz was present at the holding tank I was located at in front of the Command station at OPP. I was not interviewed by anyone in charge at the time or later, until months later, to which there was no proper filing of Medical Records or a proper incident report filed. I was relocated to HOO and was not given a blanket for several days in a dirty cell on the ninth floor and a deputy named Griffin verbally said that this is not the building to saying anything about what happen to me, or filing a grievance about it, and we're still being stripped searched.

I wrote a letter to you back in January concerning the Decree. I sent it to your address to whom it may concern. With the name and case # on the front. I am sorry if I wanted to much, or if it was just misunderstood. I'm not the most educated. Anyway concerning the Decree there is no mention of Area Reps no mention of them in any part. A Tier Rep is just that a rep of the Tier. However he is also law and order. And in return for a job well done. A.K.A. Keepin peace Kickin your ass, stabbing you, Rapin you, he is not punished. Area Reps are bad for the jail. And so much a part of this jail that no one knows the federal court outlawed them in this capacity in the 1983 case *Reynolds vs Estell* same as turn keys or building tenders.

Also Medication. My friend Ricky Russell 26 years old died this week. I don't need to wait till next week or month to know that his medication killed him. I know it did. And I can't believe that Dr. Gore defends the keep or person policy for Mental Health patients. Please excuse my spelling p, q, r, s, t, u, v, w, x, y, z. Anyway the poor kid was really going through hell. And ask for help from the Nurses assistant. She laughed call him crazy for sure. Gave him 45 Wellbutin and he

never woke up. I contacted the newspaper so I could atleast be a friend to Rick he had no one else. And get his battery out. That being he was remorseful and hurt for what he did. He told me daily he wished he could take it back. That happened last week, ^{the} medical staff has now tried to put hits on me by stating I was getting them fired. But that's another letter. Medication is traded & transferred here like street drugs ask anyone. They need to stop the way it's done. I saw Keith Prushan get his medication stolen last year on D-2-OPP howell as David Marx ^{D-2-OPP} and the list goes on I have seen assaults and meds taken from people. It's bad all the way around. And Rick Russell may still be alive if Dr. Hare wasn't trying so hard to be part of security and spent more time concerned with his Dept.

Judge not all is bad here I want to commend S.D.P. and My Warden Major League and Officer Savage and a few others that try but have their hands tied. Our Sheriff is a great politician but a horrible Lawman and supervisor and its times like this when excuses ~~and~~ are all we hear when it comes to human life.

I also don't like the Inwence machines they just put in. They give the inmate no privacy to his grievance. It will help the sheriff but hurt us if we fear filling one out. They already call them inmate sheets. I feel they need to be 3 part one being signed and dated left with the inmate. And a time line of return.

I feel that extremely strict punishment be placed on those who are found in possession of knives or other dangerous weapons. Or anyone assaulting anyone. I will leave it at that for now. With my last request. That you do with this what should be done. I wrote you another letter it was tampered and all this was sent to me asking me to file a suit. It was in Apr 2013. I have many other issues but don't know what to do since. I followed instructions and my letter was denied.
