This national program, which supports National Social Studies Standards, introduces students to the structure, function and operations of the federal courts. Activities for the day include a mock trial and sentencing role-play with behind-the scenes justice system staff introducing students to the wide variety of career opportunities available to them. Students and their teachers will interact directly with federal judges, court staff, attorneys from the U.S. Attorney Office and the Federal Defender's Office, U.S. Marshals, Probation and Pretrial Service representatives, investigators, court reporters, paralegals and others as they increase their knowledge of the court system. In addition, the Court will award scholarships to two students and commemorative gavels as part of an essay contest.

To be eligible to participate and ensure a meaningful experience for all at this civic education event, teachers have confirm their willingness to comply with preparatory guidelines and commit to encouraging their students to actively engage presenters throughout the course of this unique forum by attending a Teacher's Orientation at the Court on November 5, 2003, from 4:00 - 6:00 p.m. The orientation also includes a tour of the courthouse. The lesson plan meets National Social Studies Standards and can be taught in one or two class periods in preparation for the event.
